

# Data Collection Notice

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires the use of the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) and the Coordinated Entry System (CES). These systems help improve services, assess needs, and track the effectiveness of community efforts. Data may include your personal information, such as name, SSN, date of birth, demographics, health status, and services received.

## Use of Your Information

- Assess and improve your access to services and housing.
- Track community needs and service effectiveness.
- Share aggregate (non-identifiable) data for reporting purposes.

## Your Rights

- You have the right to review your HMIS and CES records.
- You can revoke consent at any time by submitting written notice.
- Unauthorized access to your data is prohibited.
- Agencies must keep your information confidential and secure.

## Sharing Your Information

Your data may be shared among authorized agencies for case management and referral purposes. A list of participating agencies is available upon request. You may choose to store your information anonymously, and you can change this choice at any time.
