We have created a list of common items requested by the homeless families we serve. Your donations hold value not only for the family who receives them, but also for these programs. Donations like these also help us meet a very important piece of our program requirement; In-Kind and Match. Both of our homeless programs have a match requirement, which means that for every dollar in funding we receive, we have to find donations of time, services, or monetary match.

**Time/Services**- Some families might be looking at moving in a home that needs some minor repairs or they are in charge of the yardwork. If you're a handy person or just love doing yard work and would like to donate your time, your volunteered services would be amazing. Also, we will be needing volunteers to help us with our annual Point In Time. Volunteers help complete surveys with those who are literally homeless during the last week of January.

**Money**-if you would prefer to simply send a financial donation, please let us know. Monetary donations should be noted regarding preference of county for them to be used in, or if you prefer that they are used for either CoC or ESG. If you would like the money to go towards a specific item/activity, mark that as well.
